STATEMENT ON THE CURRICULUM FOLLOWED BY IMPAQ

Impag follows the National Curriculum (CAPS) which implies that the curriculum requirements are equal to those expected from public schools, as it complies with the minimum requirements set by the National Curriculum.

In using the learning material and assessments of Impaq, as a curriculum provider, learners are enabled to progress according to the CAPS requirements, as aligned to the requirements of NQF levels 1-4.

Impag's (i) material and (ii) assessments (SBAs and end-of-year exams) are set by competent assessors, meaning that they are professionally qualified educators registered with the South African Council of Educators (SACE) (in accordance with the Government Notice of the Department of Basic Education No. 1239 of 16 November 2018). All assessments are quality assured through internal and external moderation, as well as annual moderation by the Assessment Body (SACAI) which is quality assured by Umalusi.

By adhering to the national curriculum requirements, learners will be able to move horizontally (between schools) and articulate vertical between the various NQF levels according to the promotion requirements stipulated by the DBE in the 2016 National

Policy pertaining to the programme and promotion requirements of the National Curriculum Statement for Grades R-12 (Government Notices No 1496 and 1497 in Government Regulations Gazette No 40472).
